Course aim

The aim of this course is to provide medical students with knowledge and skills associated with current medical trends in care of elderly population. Students take part in clinical practice, history taking, examination and learn how to identify acute and chronic infectious diseases from the standpoint of general practitioners. Students also learn about basic methods of medical research.

Expected outcome of the course:

Students will acquire knowledge in the field of pathogenesis, clinical picture and therapy of common diseases and conditions in elderly population and specific features of this age group. Special attention is paid to the importance of preventive medical measures and procedures, such as depistage, to be implemented. Particular attention is also paid to care and treatment of the elderly who need long-term palliative care.
